

Public Consultation Summary of key changes – TASCC Standard Review 2024

This document provides a summary overview of the key changes made to the TASCC Standard 2021 for the next issue to be implemented in 2024.

- The title has been changed from a Code of Practice to a Standard.
- Clauses have been aligned across the three schemes FEMAS, TASCC and UFAS.
- Clauses which have been reviewed, updated or are new to the Standard are highlighted in the clause column as 'Updated' or 'New'
- The modules for Simple Processing and Packing which previously were separate appendices have been brought into the main standard document.
- Guidance has been split into three sections.
 - o Interpretation details how to demonstrate compliance with the clause requirement, this is an auditable requirement.
 - o Guidance gives further explanation as to how to comply.
 - o Information contains web links.
- The sequence of the Haulage Standard clauses has been changed.
