Medicated Feed

- Huge issue for livestock industry
- Public concern around antimicrobial resistance;
- Prolonged discussion with UK Government,
 EU Commission and European Parliament

Defending Endocrine disruptors

Loss of active ingredients could mean:

- UK farm output down by £1.6bn/year
- 44,000 jobs lost in food and drink industry
- UK farming profit down by 36%




Working in partnership

- Government, AHDB and industry already invested £1.5m







Ammonia production – a success story




EU Emissions Trading Scheme







