





The impact of losing plant protection products on UK food production














Loss of active ingredients could mean:

- UK farm output down by £1.6bn/year
- 44,000 jobs lost in food and drink industry
- UK farming profit down by 36%







Average annual wheat crop = 15 million tonnes



Reduced pesticide availability (DWD, SUD, WFD)

Black-grass resistance

Loss of neonicotinoids

Endocrine disruptors

Restricted fertiliser use (NVZs)

Potential annual wheat crop = 8 million tonnes
